Its purpose was to support our employees' passions by providing ten nonprofit organizations in our communities with a \$10,000 donation to be used for a project that would significantly impact the ongoing success of their programs.

Here is how each organization was impacted by the donation:

The grant will provide home laptops, educational software, and training for 33 families.

Investing in a gift that keeps on giving.

PowerMyLearning, whose mission is to help students in low-income communities harness the power of digital learning to improve educational outcomes, will be able to deliver laptops, educational tools, and training to students and their families at an under-served elementary school.

Helping more people.

HouseProud will be able to take on 10 additional projects per year because of the Impact10 grant.

Helping provide peace of mind.

House Proud will be able to provide more no-cost repairs to low-income senior homeowners in greater downtown Atlanta neighborhoods by purchasing a truck and enclosed trailer for moving tools and materials from site to site.



Giving caregivers the support they need.

The Impact10 grant will fund caregiver info sessions across the state of Georgia that provide caregivers with the information and support they need to take care of those affected by Alzheimer's.



The need is real.

Georgia will see a 46% increase in people living with Alzheimer's disease over the next 10 years.

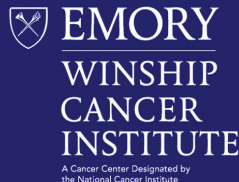

The Winship Cancer Institute will be able to provide dynamic, interactive education to their patients and caregivers at the point of care. Patients and caregivers will have access to tablets so they can view web-based education during cancer treatment opportunities.

Breaking the cycle of homelessness.

Charlotte Family Housing will be able to more efficiently reach homeless families in the Charlotte area. Through the use of new tablets, CFH will save time collecting paperwork, allowing them to service more families.

With the grant, Gideon's Promise will create a toolkit to assist public defenders with educating their communities about the public defense crisis, convey the significance of supporting their work, and facilitate discussion on how the community can help.

Helping improve water quality.

Chattahoochee Riverkeeper will use the grant to invest in a laboratory water probe that will help the organization more efficiently track and locate harmful pollution sources flowing through the waterways in our parks and neighborhoods.

Creating opportunity for those in crisis.

Mosaic Family Services will be able to provide clients with access to a new resource center. The center will allow thousands of Mosaic clients to have access to technology to help them complete paperwork, apply for jobs, and become self-sufficient.

Helping families in their most difficult times.

The Emery Funkhouser's Kisses for Hearts Memorial Fund will be able to help families who are supporting their children through long hospital stays. By building a kitchen facility in the cardiac intensive care unit of the Sibley Heart Center at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, families will be able to prepare and safely store meals while staying in the hospital with their children.
